1. Programs to be supported

2. Amount

Target: 1 billion yen (Non-cash donations accepted)

3. Donation period

April 1, 2012 through March 31, 2018

4. To apply to make a donation

Donations may be made by credit card payment, online application, or post mail.

- (1) Making a donation with a credit card
Go to the credit card payment page on the RIKEN Donations website. Enter the required information and click the Send button.
- (2) Using the online application form
Enter the required information on the application form on the RIKEN Donations website and click the Send button.
- (3) Post mail application form
Fill out the separately provided application form and send to the address given below.
